Step 1:

Connect to the FP-Guest WiFi connection

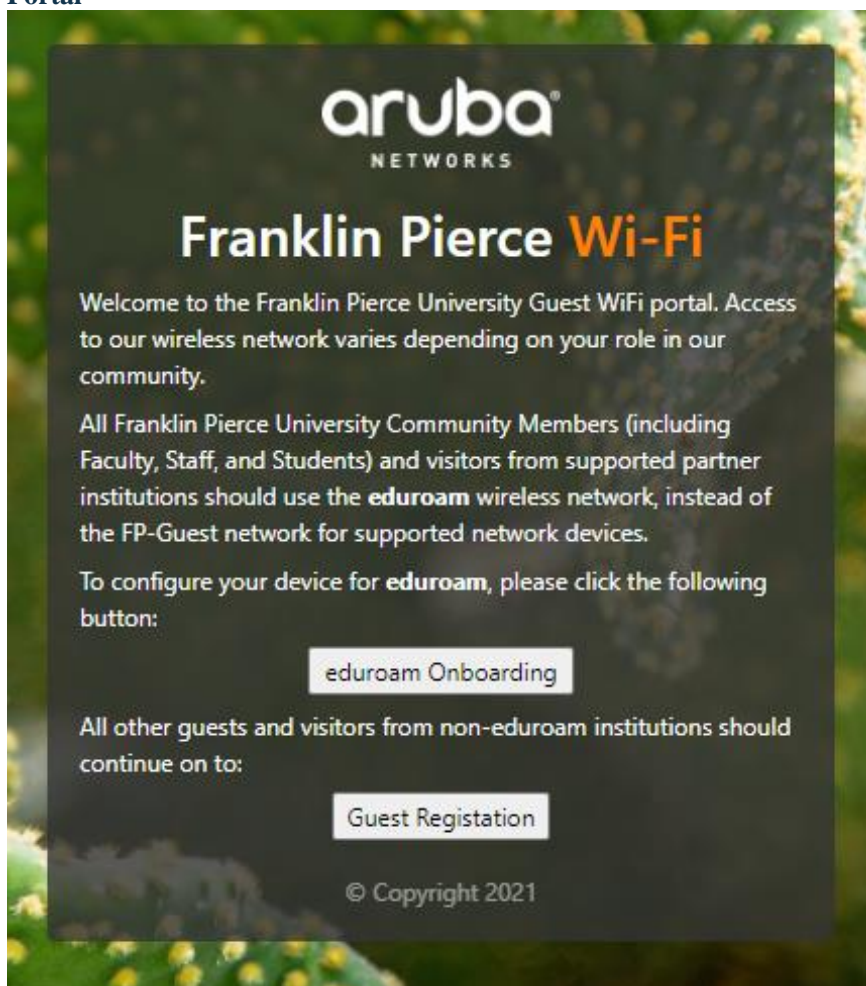
- You should be prompted to "Sign In"
- IF you are NOT prompted to sign in navigate to:

and skip to **step 3**

Step 2:

At the screen below navigate to the [insert name] button to access the Franklin Pierce Onboarding Portal



Step 3:

At the Franklin Pierce Onboarding portal enter your username followed by *@franklinpierce.edu*.
Example: doec@franklinpierce.edu
