


Accessing Remote Applications from Windows FPU Computers

These instructions will explain how to access applications from the new Jenzabar Hosted environment on Microsoft Windows-based Franklin Pierce University computers.


1. While connected to the campus network, click the following link:
\\pierce\netlogon\scripts\jz_install.bat
NOTE: Script will not work from off-campus locations.
2. A command window will display for a few moment and disappear.
3. Go the Start menu, then All Programs, the new applications are located under RemoteApp and Desktop Connections:



4. The specific applications you have available may vary based on your position and permissions.
5. Choose the application you wish to launch and it will connect to the server and load the application.
6. These applications will work from your FPU computer whether or not you are on-campus or at a off-site location such as home, or a coffee shop.

Adding Application Shortcuts to your Desktop

1. If you wish to have the application icon on your Desktop, navigate the application in the Start menu
2. Right-click and from the context menu, choose Sent to, then Desktop (create shortcut):



3. You will now have a shortcut to the application on your Desktop.
