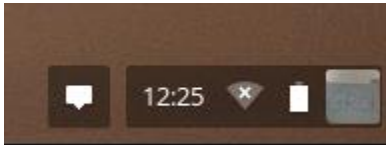

## FPU Wireless Settings

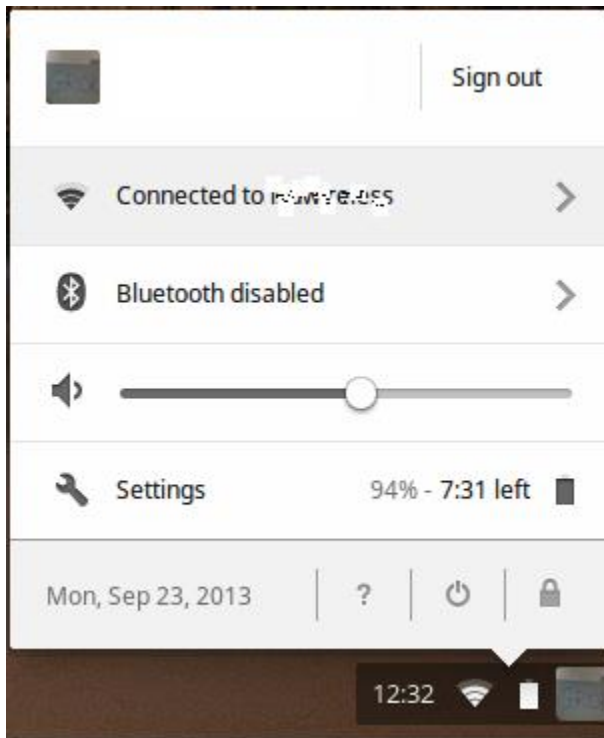
- **SSID:** eduroam
- **EAP Method:** PEAP
- **Phase 2 Authentication:** MSCHAPv2
- **Server CA Certificate:** Default
- **User Certificate:** None Installed
- **Identity:** username@franklinperce.edu (ex. *doej18@franklinperce.edu*)
- **Password:** FPU Password (same password you use for CampusWeb or Canvas)
- **Anonymous Identity:** Empty

## Connect a Chromebook to eduroam Wireless

1. Click the **WiFi icon** at the bottom right of the screen.



2. Click the section labeled "Connected to <network>" (or other SSID) and select **eduroam** from the menu.



3. Enter Wi-Fi Network Settings for eduroam:

NOTE: In some instances, you may have to change the **Server CA Certificate** to 'Do Not Check'.
