

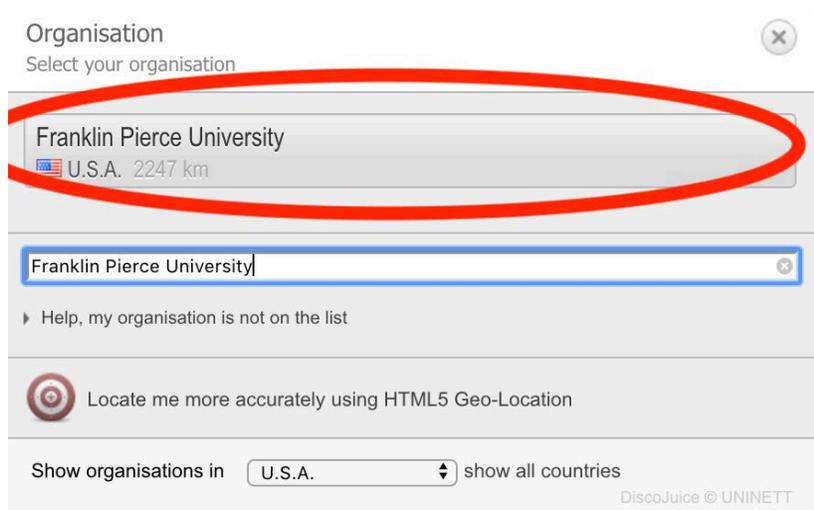
PC Computers (non-FPU machines)

1. Open a web browser (Chrome, Edge, Firefox), and navigate to cat.eduroam.org
2. Once the page has loaded, click the button on the bottom of the page labeled (Click here to download your eduroam installer)

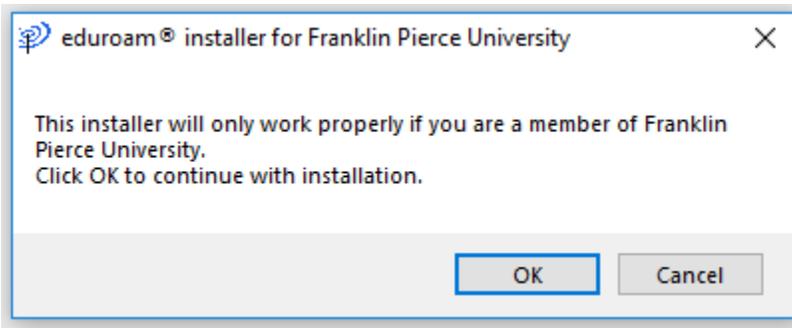

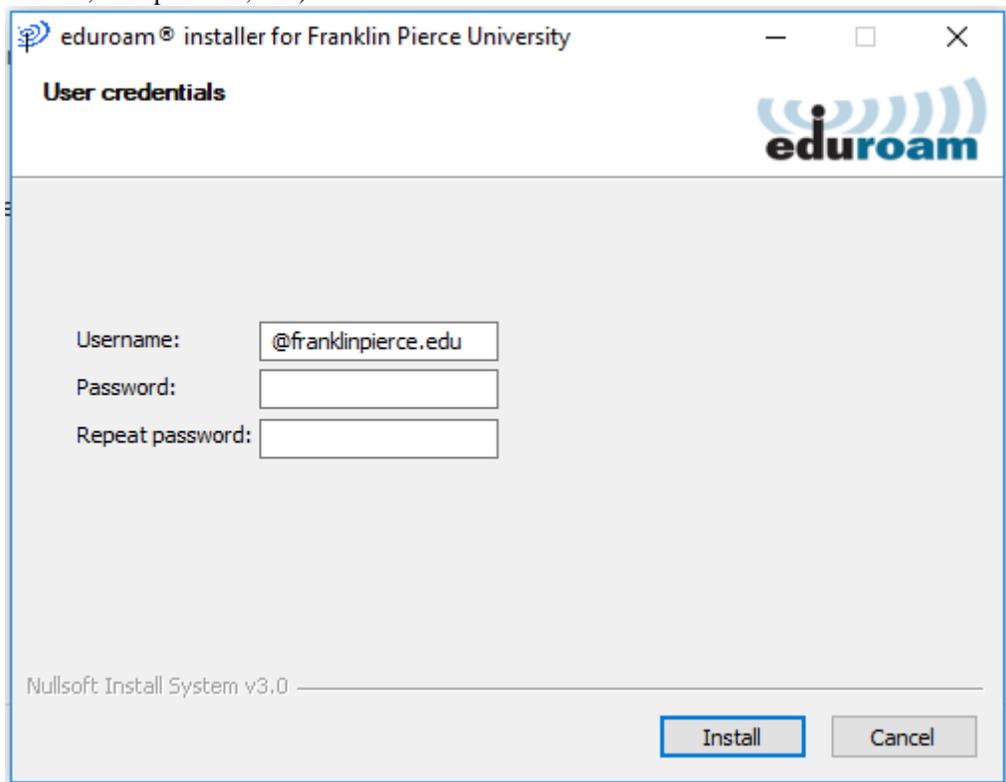

5. Once the file has downloaded, click on the download in the lower, left hand corner of your screen (if using Google Chrome, see image on left, below) or the top, right hand corner of your screen (if using Firefox) *Note: if prompted to open, save or run download, select "run"

6. Once the configuration file is opened, you will be asked to continue in a new window. Select "Next" and you should see the warning below, and click OK:



7. Enter your username (placed **BEFORE** @franklinpiece.edu) and your FPU login password (same as Canvas, CampusWeb, etc.)



8. Click "Install" initiating the installation process.

9. Once complete you should be able to hit "Next" and see the status of the **eduroam** connection. It is recommended you restart your computer and log in, verifying you are now able to connect to **eduroam**.
