TIP: The most common error is failing to include "@franklinpierce.edu" when typing your username to connect to the eduroam

Profile Install

1. Open Safari and download the Franklin Pierce University eduroam profile found here (or using the qr code) to take you to the eduroam page. Click the link to download the profile and begin installation.





2. A warning that the eduroam site is trying to make changes to your device, select Allow to proceed.



3. The Install Profile window displays as shown below, select Install to continue.



4. If prompted, enter the passcode for your device.
